

## Barbara's Cue-Sheets

The cue-sheet indicates the syllables that start in each measure. For everything else, I study the sheet music and rehearsal CD and lift mine eyes to the Dawn. The process of making a cue-sheet helps me understand a song's structure and patterns, and then it is easy to learn and even memorize.

A cue-sheet is for one or more vocal parts, as indicated by the final letter(s) in the filename. For example, cheat\_i\_see\_a\_star\_SA is for soprano and alto (S and A). If a cue-sheet is for more than one part, check the top of the page for any typographic indications (**color**, **bold**, *italic*) of which part is singing when.

If numbers appear above the lyrics, they indicate pitches (degrees of the scale).
